A Man with a Vision

When the West was wild and the railroads were a new mode of travel, the Dodge family chose Council Bluffs as their home and constructed one of the finest mansions west of the Mississippi.

General Grenville M. Dodge was called “the greatest railroad builder of all time” because



of his role as chief construction engineer of the Union Pacific Railroad and his subsequent railroading career, which spanned the globe.

The Historic General Dodge House was built in 1869 and restored in 1964. The handsome, three-story Victorian home has 14 rooms and stands in prominence high on a bluff overlooking the

Missouri River valley.

The City of Council Bluffs and the Board of Trustees continue to preserve and restore the home to its Victorian roots. The home is maintained as a house-museum and is a treasured local and national Landmark.
